Close of Entries:

Entries will close at **10pm on Tuesday 24 March 2026.**

Entries open on Tuesday 3 March 2026 and will only be accepted online via **Equipe by visiting the championship finals 2026 page on www.bluechipchamps.co.uk**

If you have any queries, please contact the Show Secretary on amanda@showdirect.co.uk.

Entries may close to competitions for which qualification is not required prior to 10.00pm on 24 March 2026 if classes are over-subscribed on any given day.

Show Ground Access:

Horses may arrive on the showground **from 2.00pm on Tuesday 7 April**. Horses requiring stables must arrive before 7.30pm as the Stable Managers Office will close at 8.00pm. Access to the Show Ground will be from 6.00am – 11.00pm on Show days. Outside these times the entrance will be opened for emergency access only.

Horses / Ponies requiring stabling must arrive on the showground before 7.30pm. Should any competitor be delayed, they must contact the **Stable Manager on 07487 423 564**.

Vaccination Certificate:

All horses and ponies at the Blue Chip Championships must have a current and valid certificate of vaccination against Equine Influenza.

Please read Point 38 in the Blue Chip Winter Show Jumping Championships General Rules & Regulations. **There will be random checking of certificates, and any horse or pony found without a valid certificate will not be permitted to remain at the Show.**

Show Ground Stabling:

Stables must be booked on-line. There will be 75 Permanent Barn Stables at £58 per night, plus Temporary Barn Stables at £38 per night, available on the showground. Competitors must ensure that there is availability on all nights for permanent stable bookings before booking, and only book stables for horses they have entered in classes. Requests for proximity to other riders should be made in the stabling notes. Competitors who wish to be placed on the waiting list for permanent stables need to email amanda@showdirect.co.uk

Stables must only be booked in the riders name and not booked for friends. Requests can be added in the stable notes.

Horses may not arrive before 2.00pm on 7 April and all horses must depart on Sunday 12 April.

Stable hire is from 5.00pm on day of arrival – 4.00pm on the day of departure (access from 2.00pm on Tuesday 7 April). Stables must be vacated on time so that incoming horses may be stabled. If stables are not vacated on time a fine of £80 per stable may be charged for late departure.

All Competitors will pay a **£20 per stable cash deposit** upon arrival at the Stable Managers Office prior to being allocated stables. This deposit is fully refundable prior to departure and upon confirmation that the Competitors stable has been emptied of bedding and left tidy. If the stable is not emptied of bedding and left tidy the deposit will not be refunded.

Any damage caused to stables will be charged to the hirer.

Horseboxes / trailers may be parked some distance from the stables.

Competitors may not sub-let or re-sell any stables they have purchased and are then unable and / or don't wish to use themselves.

Stable Manager's Office is open daily from 7.00am – 8.00pm

Stable Bedding :

Permanent stables will be empty of bedding at the start of occupancy and the stable must have all bedding completely removed at the end of the hire period. Temporary stables may have bedding remaining from the previous occupant, the Stable Manager will advise on how the stable should be left prior to departure. This must be completed for the Stable Deposit to be returned. No bedding whatsoever is provided with the hire of the stable.

Natural Flake Shavings may be purchased from the Stable Manager at £11.00 per bale between 9.00am and 8.00pm.

Straw is not permitted.

Haylage :

HorseHage may be purchased from the Stable Manager £9.00 per bale between 9.00am and 8.00pm.

Electric Lorry Hook Up :

Limited 6amp electrical hook ups are available for horseboxes at a cost of £105 (inc. VAT) per hook up for the period that the Competitor is staying on the Show Ground and may not be transferred to another Competitor. Horseboxes will require a 16amp (blue socket) extension cable (which must conform to current electrical regulations) to connect to the socket supplied.

Whilst the Organiser will endeavour to supply the hook up booked the Organiser does not guarantee a constant supply throughout the Show, nor do we accept any responsibility for losses and / or discomfort occurring as a result of a break in the supply provided.

Electrical connection must be booked on-line and is on a strictly first come basis. No refunds can be made on any cancelled bookings on or after 24 March 2026.

First Aid:

A fee of £7 per day per Competitor will be charged towards medical cover during the hours of competition.

Meals:

Evening meals available from 4.00pm on Tuesday 7 April.

Breakfast will be available from 7.30am

Hot & Cold food throughout the day.

Evening Meals available until 8.30pm

Bar available during normal licensing hours

Drawn Order:

All classes are drawn order and competitors must declare to the Steward in the warm-up arena prior to the start of each competition.

The drawn orders will be posted on www.bluechipchamps.co.uk from 4.00pm on Monday 6 April.

Prize Giving:

All competitors winning prizes listed in the schedule for all competitions in the Championship Arena and Manor Arena will be expected to attend the Official Prize Giving. The Show Organiser reserves the right to withhold prizes if competitors do not attend the Official Prize Giving.

Prize Money:

Prize money will be paid either by refund back to the card used for paying the entry fees, or by bacs transfer if the amount won is greater than the amount paid. Please make sure that your bank details are correct in your Equipe account. We will not be responsible for monies being paid to incorrect accounts if the information given is not correct.

Special Prizes:

All special prizes must be collected from the Show Secretary prior to departure from the Show Ground. Pony competitors must be accompanied by an adult. Prizes will not be forwarded after the event.

Gifts for Finalists:

Blue Chip Feed have kindly provided a baseball cap and stable plaques for all qualified finalists who compete in a Championship Final. These may be collected from the Show Secretary's Office during the Show. These are restricted to one per person.

Pony Height Certificates:

All ponies competing in classes 19, 31, 33, 38, 41 must have a current British Showjumping or FEI measuring certificate as per British Showjumping Rule 45.6. Please refer to the British Showjumping Members Online Handbook for further information.

Pony Boot Rule:

British Showjumping Rule 102.15 in the British Showjumping Members Online Handbook will apply to all pony competitions at the Blue Chip Championships.

Refund Policy for Entries and Stable Fees:

Refunds of entries will only be made in accordance with British Showjumping Rule 79.5. Stabling fees will not be refunded for stables cancelled on or after 24 March 2026.

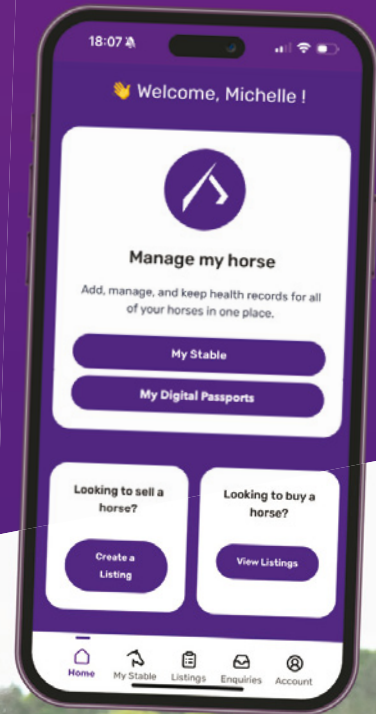

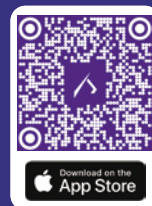
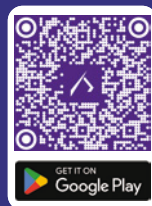

In particular you acknowledge that the Organiser shall not under any circumstances be responsible for any loss, injury, illness or damage to (whether or not foreseeable and howsoever caused), or any theft from, any Competitor, any horse or other animal, any vehicle, or any other property whatsoever in the Show Ground, providing that nothing shall exclude or limit the Organiser's liability for the death of or personal injury to any person caused by its negligence or that of its employees or agents.

BLUE CHIP WINTER SHOW JUMPING CHAMPIONSHIPS

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Please read these General Rules and Regulations carefully. By entering, attending, or being in any way involved in any aspect of the Show, you indicate that you accept and agree to comply with these General Rules and Regulations.

- 1. DEFINITIONS** – In these General Rules and Regulations the term “**Competitor**” refers to every Entrant and Associated Person. The term “**Entrant**” refers to all exhibitors and competitors entering the Show. The term “**Associated Person**” refers to all owners, riders, handlers, drivers, grooms, and parents / guardians of competitors under the age of 17 associates and / or supporters of Entrants. The term “**Show**” refers to the event known as the Blue Chip Winter Show Jumping Championships held at Addington Equestrian, Addington, Buckingham, Buckinghamshire, MK18 2JR (the “**Show Ground**”). The term “**Organiser**” refers to Show Direct Ltd incorporated and registered in England and Wales with company number 04558504 and all its employees, officers, representatives, volunteers and show officials. The term “**Show Secretary**” refers to Amanda Bywater or such other person as may be appointed to perform such role. The term “**Entry**” refers to the online entry submitted by all Entrants.
- 2. RESPONSIBILITY** – The Organiser shall not under any circumstances be responsible for any loss, injury, illness or damage to (whether or not foreseeable and howsoever caused), or any theft from, any Competitor, any horse or other animal, any vehicle, or any other property whatsoever in the Show Ground, provided that nothing shall exclude or limit the Organiser's liability for the death of or personal injury to any person caused by its negligence or that of its employees or agents.
Any items brought into the Show Ground or left in vehicles or tack lockers (whether locked or not) are at the Competitor's own risk. Competitors shall take such steps as are necessary to secure their property whilst in the Show Ground.
Competitors are responsible for ensuring that their horses are in good health and each Competitor shall take all necessary steps to prevent the contracting or spread of any disease or illness at the Show.
Competitors will be responsible for reimbursing the Organiser for all liabilities, costs, expenses, damages and losses (including but not limited to any direct, indirect or resulting losses, loss of profit, loss of reputation and all interest, penalties and legal costs and all other reasonable professional costs and expenses) suffered or incurred by the Organiser arising out of or in connection with any breach of these Rules and Regulations by the Competitor or anyone under the control of the Competitor.
All Children under the age of 17 must be accompanied by a responsible adult and may not be left at the Show unaccompanied.
Each Entrant will be considered responsible in all respects for the acts and/or failures to act of their Associated Persons. The Entrant shall be responsible for the consequences of any infringement by its Associated Persons of these Rules and Regulations.
Competitors are personally responsible for ensuring that they take all necessary measures with regards to health and safety. Upon any entry to any competition at the Show each Competitor acknowledges that he/she is taking part in a risk sport and represents that he/she is a competent rider at the level of competition in which he/she has entered.
Competitors who suffer a fall or any other injury whilst in the Show Ground must report the fall / injury to the Show Secretary. Competitors shall comply with the rules of Addington Equestrian and any reasonable instructions given to them by the Organisers.
- 3. INSURANCE** – Competitors are personally responsible for damage to: any buildings, land, equipment, or other property in the Show Ground; or to any third persons caused by the Competitor, their employees, their agents, or their horses / ponies. It is strongly advised that Competitors have in force third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in and attendance at the Show.
- 4. ADDITIONAL FEES** – The Organiser reserves the right to charge an additional fee to Competitors should extraordinary circumstances arise which require procedures to be implemented that would not normally be anticipated or expected, but were considered by the Organiser to be in the best interests for the wellbeing of either Competitors, horses and animals, general public and / or the successful running of the Championships.
- 5. REMOVAL FROM THE SHOW** – The Organiser retains at its absolute discretion the right to decline entry or exclude or remove any person or animal from the Show or future shows or return any entry fee without being required to assign any reason or being liable to the Competitor for any compensation.
- 6. QUALIFICATION** – Horses / Ponies that have qualified may be ridden by British Showjumping members other than those at the time of qualification. Horses / Ponies are deemed qualified for the final at the point of qualification, even if they subsequently move up a grade prior to the final.
- 7. COMPETITIONS** – The Organiser reserves the right to cancel, add to, or amend any of the competitions or the Show, as they deem appropriate (with the approval of British Showjumping).

8. **ENTRIES** – In all classes entries are confined to members of British Showjumping and registered horses in accordance with British Showjumping Rule 77.
9. **FIRST AID** – A fee of £7 per day per Competitor will be charged towards medical cover during the hours of competition.
10. **RE-PRESENTED PAYMENT** – Any payment that has to be re-presented to the bank for whatever reason will be subject to a £20.00 administration fee each time it is re-presented.
11. **VAT RECEIPTS** – All entries, medical, stable and hook-up fees include VAT. A receipt may be requested from the Show Secretary but must be accompanied by a SAE.
12. **REFUND OF ENTRY AND STABLE FEES** – Refunds of entries will only be made in accordance with British Showjumping Rule 79.5. Stabling fees will not be refunded for stables cancelled on or after 24 March 2026. Payment of refunds will only be made after the Championships.
13. **COLLECTING RING** – All warming up must be done in the designated “Collecting Rings” provided and numbers will be strictly limited. Competitors found abusing the showground may be asked to leave the Show Ground.
14. **DRESS** – Hard hats, which comply with current British Showjumping safety requirements, must be worn at all times when mounted. Competitors must be correctly dressed when walking the course.
15. **PRIZE GIVING** – The Organisers reserve the right to withhold prizes if Competitors do not attend the Official Prize Giving. All Competitors winning prizes listed in the schedule for all competitions in the Addington Championship Arena and Manor Arena will be expected to attend the Official Prize Giving. British Showjumping Rule 202.1a will apply.
16. **PRIZE MONEY** – Prize money will be paid either by refund back to the card used for paying the entry fees, or by bacs transfer if the amount won is greater than the amount paid. 23. **MOTORBIKES, SCOOTERS, BICYCLES AND QUAD BIKES** – Except for authorised official vehicles used by the Organiser, motorbikes, scooters, bicycles or quad bikes are not permitted at the Show. Disability vehicles are permitted.
24. **SMOKING** – There is a NO SMOKING policy which covers all areas of the Show Ground with the exception of the designated smoking areas.
25. **BARBECUES** – No barbecues are permitted in the Show Ground.
26. **DOGS** – Dogs are permitted in the Show Ground but must be kept on a lead and under control at all times. If, in the opinion of the Organiser, any person fails to control their dog/s they may be asked to leave the Show Ground.
27. **OBJECTIONS** – Objections should be made in writing in accordance with British Showjumping Rule 198. A £150 deposit in cash or card will be required per objection.
28. **OFFICIAL PHOTOGRAPHS AND FILM FOOTAGE** – It is understood and agreed by any Competitor attending the Show that permission is granted to the Organiser for any photographs and / or film footage taken at the Show by any official photographer or film company to be used by the Organiser for security, promotional and / or live streaming purposes, furthermore the Competitor agrees that permission is without any payment.
29. **VETERINARY SURGEON** – The services of a vet are only available “On Call”. Competitors are responsible for any costs incurred in making such call outs. If required, these can be contacted via the Stable Manager’s Office.
30. **FARRIER** – Please note that there is no Farrier on call. A list of local farriers is available at the Secretary’s Office.
31. **SHOWGROUND ACCESS** – Horses may arrive on the showground from 2.00pm on Tuesday 7 April. Horses requiring stables must arrive before 7.30pm as the Stable Managers Office will close at 8.00pm. The Show Ground entrance will be closed at 11.00pm. Access to the Show Ground will be from 6.00am – 11.00pm on Show days. Outside of these times the entrance will be opened for emergency access only.
Horses requiring stabling must arrive on the showground before 7.30pm. Should any Competitor be delayed, they must contact the **Stable Manager** on **07487 423564**. **Stable Managers Office will close at 8.00pm each night.**
Only horseboxes / trailers bringing horses and / or ponies intending to compete at the Show will be admitted to the Show Ground.
32. **STABLING** – There will be 75 Permanent Barn Stables at £58 per night, plus Temporary Barn Stables at £38 per night, available on the showground. Competitors must ensure that there is availability on all nights for permanent stable bookings before booking, and only book stables for horses they have entered in classes. Requests for proximity to other riders should be made in the stabling notes. Competitors who wish to be placed on the waiting list for permanent stables need to email amanda@showdirect.co.uk **Stables must be booked on-line.**

Stables must only be booked in the riders name and not booked for friends. Requests can be added in the stable notes.

If you wish to increase the number of nights a horse is stabled once the initial stable booking is made, please contact the **Show Secretary on 07855 663358** to amend your booking.

Horses may not arrive before 2.00pm on Tuesday 7 April 2026 and all horses must depart on Sunday 12 April 2026.

Stable hire is from 5.00pm on day of arrival – 4.00pm on the day of departure (access from 2.00pm on Tuesday 7 April). Stables must be vacated on time so that incoming horses may be stabled. If stables are not vacated on time a fine of £80 per stable may be charged for late departure.

Permanent stables will be empty of bedding at the start of occupancy and the stable must have all bedding completely removed at the end of the hire period. Temporary stables may have bedding remaining from the previous occupant, the Stable Manager will advise on how the stable should be left prior to departure. This must be completed for the Stable Deposit to be returned. No bedding whatsoever is provided with the hire of the stable.

All Competitors will pay a **£20 per stable deposit in cash** only upon arrival at the Stable Managers Office prior to being allocated stables. This deposit is fully refundable prior to departure and upon confirmation that the Competitors stable has been cleared as above. If a permanent stable is not emptied of bedding or a temporary stable not left tidy the deposit will not be refunded. Wheelbarrows are recommended.

Should the Permanent Barn Stables not be filled on every night, horses may be upgraded.

Should space be available late stabling requests may be accepted after 24 March, however, they will be subject to an additional fee of £5 per stable per night. Please contact the Show Secretary on 07790 309424 to amend your booking.

Any damage caused to stables will be charged to the hirer.

Horseboxes / trailers may be parked some distance from the stables.

Competitors may not sub-let or re-sell any stables they have purchased and are then unable and / or don't wish to use themselves.

Stable Manager's Office is open daily from 7.00am – 8.00pm

33. **HORSES STABLED ON VEHICLES** – Horses may not be stabled in horseboxes / trailers. A Competitor deemed by the Organiser to be stabling their horse / pony in such a way will be asked to leave the Show Ground.
34. **UNAUTHORISED USE OF STABLES** – Any Competitor who enters or makes use of any stable that has not been officially reserved for their use will be liable for the daily charge for that stable (as set out in point 31) and an additional fine of £80 for that stable.
35. **STABLE BEDDING** – Permanent stables will be empty of bedding at the start of occupancy and the stable must have all bedding completely removed at the end of the hire period. Temporary stables may have bedding remaining from the previous occupant, the Stable Manager will advise on how the stable should be left prior to departure. This must be completed for the Stable Deposit to be returned. No bedding whatsoever is provided with the hire of the stable.
Natural Flake Shavings may be purchased from the Stable Managers Office at £11 per bale between 9.00am - 8.00pm. **Straw is not permitted in stables.**
36. **HAYLAGE** – Horsehage will be available to purchase on site from the Stable Managers at £9 per bag between 9.00am - 8.00pm.
37. **STORAGE OF BEDDING & FODDER** – No hay, fodder or any flammable materials may be stored by the Competitor next to or underneath their horsebox and should be stored within their vehicles. Should the Competitor fail to comply with this requirement they may be asked to leave the Show Ground.
38. **VACCINATION CERTIFICATE** – All horses and ponies at the Show must have a current and valid certificate of vaccination against Equine Influenza. All horses and ponies must have been fully vaccinated within the past twelve months before arriving at the event (or to conform to the current British Showjumping policy). Horses / Ponies must have received the full course of vaccinations or the booster at least 7 days before arriving at the Championships. **There will be random checking of certificates, and any horse or pony found without a valid certificate will not be permitted to remain at the Show.**
39. **HOOK UPS** – A limited number of 6amp electrical hook ups are available for horseboxes at a cost of £105 (inc. VAT) per hook up for the period that the Competitor is staying on the Show Ground and may not be transferred to another Competitor. Competitors must have a 16amp (blue socket) extension cable to connect to the socket supplied by the Organiser. It is the responsibility of the Competitor to ensure that all their cables and electrical equipment complies with current electrical regulations. Competitors must ensure that all electrical items in their horseboxes have a current PAT Certificate.
Whilst the Organiser will endeavour to supply the hook up booked the Organiser does not guarantee a constant supply throughout the Show, nor do we accept any responsibility for losses and / or discomfort occurring as a result of a break in the supply provided.
Electrical connection must be booked on-line and is on a strictly first come basis. No refunds can be made on any cancelled hook up bookings on or after 24 March 2026.
40. **GENERATORS** – Competitors may have generators in the horsebox parking areas providing they are moderately sized and do not reach a noise or emission level whereby, in the opinion of the Organiser, they become a nuisance. The Competitor is responsible for ensuring that any generator complies with all health and safety regulations and that all users adhere to the refuelling procedure set out in the Organiser's document: - P 04 'Refuelling vehicles and Equipment 121116' which is available on-site from the Stable Managers Office or in advance by request to the Organiser. All generators must be turned off between the hours of 11.00pm and 8.00am.
41. **HORSE WALK** – Designated walkways are available for competitors to access the competition arenas. Competitors on foot on the horse walks do so at their own risk.

42. **STALLIONS** – No person shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any class without taking adequate precautions to ensure other persons are not put at risk of injury in accordance with British Showjumping rule 102.13. Stallions must be identified on the Entry Form; failure to do so may result in the animal having to be removed from the Show Ground.
43. **REFRESHMENTS** – Available in Addington Cafe from 4.00pm – 8.30pm on Tuesday 7 April and open from 7.30am on competition days. Bar available during normal licensing hours.
44. **REFRESHMENTS DURING GALA PERFORMANCE** – The Addington Café and Addington Bar will be open to visitors during the Gala Performance. There is not requirement to have tickets to access these outlets.
45. **GALA PERFORMANCE** – Entry to the Gala Performance is free for general public and subject to the Show Ground Admission Terms & Conditions, which may be viewed at www.bluechipchamps.co.uk.
46. **PUBLIC TOILETS** – Limited public toilets will be open in the Show Ground 24 hours a day.
47. **PUBLIC SHOWERS** – Public showers are open 24 hours a day within the permanent stable block.
48. **LOST PROPERTY** – All lost property during the show will be located at the Secretary’s Office. Any inquiries regarding lost property following the conclusion of the Show should be made to Amanda Bywater at amanda@showdirect.co.uk.
49. **ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR** – Any act of anti-social behaviour, including excessive noise, will result in those responsible being required to leave the Show.
50. **CLOSE OF ENTRIES** – **Entries will close at 10.00pm on 24 March 2026** – Should space be available late entries may be accepted with an additional fee of £5.00 being charged per entry. The Organiser reserves the right to close entries to competitions or cancel competitions for which qualification is not required prior to 24 March 2026, if classes are over-subscribed on any given day.
51. **CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULE** – In all cases the official schedule for the Championships is deemed the schedule that is available to download on www.bluechipchamps.co.uk and is in conjunction with the schedule available on the British Showjumping website www.britishshowjumping.co.uk and these supersede any other versions that may be on other websites.
52. **OTHER TERMS** – If any court declares that any provision of these Rules and Regulations is invalid, unlawful or unenforceable to any extent, the provision will, to that extent, be severed from the remaining provisions, which will continue to be valid to the fullest extent permitted by law.

These Rules and Regulations are governed by English law. The Organiser and Competitor both agree to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
